Guidelines and Expectations of Travel Soccer

1. Mount Olive Travel Soccer plays within the Morris County Youth Soccer Association and equivalent associations and is bound by their rules as well as New Jersey Youth Soccer and the Mount Olive Soccer Clubs rules.
2. The travel season runs from August to July, with a commitment REQUIRED FOR BOTH FALL AND SPRING SEASONS.
3. Travel try outs are held for all Mount Olive teams in the spring for the following fall/spring season. All participants must try out to make a team.
4. When the season ends in June, all teams are disbanded and are reformed for the following year, with players who participate in the try-outs and are selected.
5. Children currently on any Mount Olive Soccer are not guaranteed a continuing spot on their existing team.
6. The travel program does not provide equal play time for all players. Each game is evaluated as the game progresses and individual skills will be called upon proportionally to achieve a positive outcome. The Mount Olive Soccer Club provides an instructional program if equal playing time is what you desire.
7. Travel Soccer requires a large time commitment. Players should expect to practice twice a week for 1 to 2 hours per session, and at least one game per week. Games per week may be increased due to weather postponements.
8. Travel Soccer may require additional weekend time for tournaments. These tournaments may be held on holidays.
9. Players are selected to the travel program following the try-out evaluations. Technical and match condition skills are evaluated. Multiple evaluation criteria are used to score every player's abilities. The team selection is made from this list. The coaches of the team will have final say on selection for their teams.
10. Final notification of selected players will be made after tryouts and close to the end of the school year. By trying out, the child is expressing a sincere interest in participating in the Travel Soccer program. At such time that the player is invited to play for a team, the club requires a prompt response (within 5 days) to allow time for the teams to be formed and registered with the appropriate leagues.
11. Mount Olive Travel Soccer participates in the S.A.G.E. (Set A Good Example) program as required by Morris County Youth Soccer. Each player and parent must sign an additional document promising adherence to these rules.
12. Players may try out for a maximum of 2 different age groups. Players may not try out for a team that is more than 1 age group above their appropriate level (For example, if you are U11 age you can not try out for U13)
13. U7 Players (born later than 7/31/2004) are NOT allowed to play Travel Soccer.
14. Games will require travel to away games. (Usually 5 per season) Travel may be in excess of 45 minutes.
15. The Mount Olive Soccer Club charges \$235.00 registration fee for fall and \$235.00 for spring for a total of \$470.
16. A uniform must be purchased for approximately \$100.00 for all travel players for the 2011/2012 seasonal year. Additional pieces are available at additional cost.
17. Additional funds may be required from each player for training and tournaments.
18. Registration and uniform fees are subject to change.
